What is Campus life?

Campus Life is a day program for young autistic adults (17 to 25 year olds) transitioning to adult life.

It includes campus locations or visits where participants can engage with tertiary students.

The curriculum is accessible, visual, engaging and suitable for adults with intellectual disability. There is de-sensitising space and support for augmented communication.



Costs



NDIS day program rate plus \$2.53 per hour for centre based capital costs.

Group therapy costs are at the NDIS Price Guide rate divided between the group.
